

**COVENTRY PARKS & RECREATION DEPT.**  
**2010 SUMMER TENNIS FACT SHEET**

- 1.) **ALL PLAYERS MUST BE FULL-TIME COVENTRY RESIDENTS. NO SUMMER RESIDENTS.**
- 2.) The program fee is \$10.00 and runs from July 13<sup>th</sup> – August 11<sup>th</sup>
- 3.) Tennis Hall of Fame trip August, 12<sup>th</sup>. Children free – Adults \$11.00
- 4.) The schedule is as follows: Tuesdays Grades 4 & 5 **Session I** 8:00am - 9:30am **Session II** 9:30am - 11:00am  
Wednesdays Grades 6 – 8 **Session I** 8:00am - 9:30am **Session II** 9:30am – 11:00am  
Wednesdays High School Boys and Girls and Adult Women 11:00am - 12:30pm
- 5.) **ALL** lessons are held on the Central Coventry Park tennis courts.
- 6.) Please drop off on time for class and pickup on time at the end of the scheduled class.
- 7.) We will provide tennis rackets for those who need them.
- 8.) We **DO NOT** offer refunds.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF PUBLIC PARKS & RECREATION AREAS**

- 1.) Town parks and recreational facilities shall be open from 7:00am-11:00pm. The Recreation Director is authorized to extend the aforesaid time limits, but only on special written permit. Unlighted areas will be closed from dusk to 7:00am.
- 2.) Littering is prohibited. All refuse and waste material shall be deposited in receptacles provided for that purpose and shall not be left on the ground or in the waters of any Town park. Picnic areas must be left clean.
- 3.) No person shall hunt, trap, or carry firearms within a park or playground area. No animal or bird in a Town park shall be harassed, injured or killed.
- 4.) No person shall cut, remove, or damage any tree or shrub within a park area, nor shall they deface any buildings or public property.
- 5.) No person shall disrobe in any public park or recreational area other than in a properly designated building.
- 6.) The Recreation Director may schedule activities on public recreation property and may issue a written permit authorizing the use of said property.
- 7.) No person shall possess, drink, sell or offer for sale, any intoxicating beverages or possess any controlled substances within the limits of a Town park or recreation area.
- 8.) No person shall offer for sale at any park or recreation area, any goods or services of a commercial nature without written permit from the recreation office.
- 9.) No person shall distribute or exhibit any printed or written matter, nor shall any person hold any public meetings at any park or recreational area without a written permit from the recreation office. When official permission is granted, the distributor or exhibitor shall be responsible for removal of all litter which may result from such distribution or exhibition.
- 10.) All written permits may be obtained from the Recreation Director or an authorized representative of the Recreation Department.

**OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES**

- 1.) No person shall operate a motor vehicle, motorcycle, snowmobile, go-cart, dirt bike, or other self-propelled vehicle in any of the parks, recreational areas or exterior school property of the Town of Coventry
- 2.) Operation and parking of the aforesaid vehicles shall be allowed in designated driveways or parking lots and, in such areas, the speed limit shall not exceed 10MPH, conditions permitting. In addition, these vehicles shall be properly registered and equipped according to the motor vehicle code of the State of Rhode Island.

**USE OF FLOODLIGHTS IN TOWN RECREATIONAL AREAS**

- 1.) The use of tennis courts shall be and are hereby restricted to a maximum of one hour per individual or group, due to the physical limitations of the facilities.

**ANIMAL CONTROL IN TOWN PARKS**

- 1.) No person shall bring into a public park any animal unless it be under control at all times on a leash, nor shall any animal be left unattended in an automobile.

**PENALTIES**

- 1.) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.
